RE: **REPORT OF DECORATING COMMITTEE MEETING**

Attendance at Decorating Committee Meeting on April 20, 2009: Pat Beattie, Anne Jacobs, Carol Korein, Bill Ribble, Peggy Stengel, Dave Lisbon

1. **Pool Furniture and Umbrellas**— In light of the current condition of the pool lounges – more and more are breaking - the Committee is **recommending replacement of all the furniture** including lounges, chairs, bar stools, tables and umbrellas. The recommendation would include getting quotes from three vendors to replace the furniture with like furniture and to obtain a 5 year warranty. Upon Board approval, Dave will move forward with this and communicate with Committee Members by email, as needed.
  - Discussion focused on what to do with present furniture that is still in reasonable condition. Options included using it during summer months as long as possible even after the new furniture has been purchased. Dave indicated that storage of the new furniture over the summer would be a problem.
  - A second consideration was to consign the furniture.
2. **Strategic Planning** – It was noted that Bill Ribble and Pat Beattie would be willing to serve on this committee. No further discussion occurred as the Board will advise on selection of members.
3. **Other Business** –
  - **Guest Room Carpets** – The Committee recommends that the carpets in the Guest Rooms be cleaned and scotchguarded on an as needed basis. The Committee will inspect the carpets on a regular basis to determine wear and tear.
  - **Clock at the Pool** – Dave advised that the clock and the thermometer at the pool will be replaced. (The clock has not been functioning properly.)
  - The Committee recommends that the signage on the table be moved to the counter in the mail room.
  - The Committee recommends that the wheelchair, currently being stored in the Exercise Room, be moved to the Billiards Room. This would still keep it accessible but out of the way.

There being no further business at this time, the meeting concluded at 10:30 AM.
