

Landscape Committee Meeting

September 16, 2008

In attendance: D. Luttrell, C. Maeder (via teleconference), S. Stinson, D. Lisbon *ex officio*

Kristin Reine Jeannin from Crawford Landscaping presented her proposals for the fall/winter plantings.

We selected her alternate proposal that will use Victoria Blue Salvia, Ultra Red Star Grandiflora Petunias, and white Alyssum in various combinations. All three will be layered in front of the Sorrento signs. The center island at the entrance will be edged by the petunias. Petunias surrounded by alyssum will ring the Royal Palms on the drive. In front of the fountain will be a semicircular row of salvia with alyssum in the front. Petunias will also be planted behind the spa.

Crawford will use cypress mulch for the fall mulching. For budgetary reasons we need to cut back a bit on the amount of mulch applied, so we asked that the most visible areas be mulched first.

The Pink Anthurium near our front door has a lot of brown leaves. Kristin says the southeast plants may get too much sun; the general problem, though, seems to be a fungus attack. Crawford will be replanting Pink Anthurium there since they are still under warranty and treating the plants with an anti-fungicide.

The target date for the seasonal plantings is November 1.
