Members present at the meeting....Carol Korein, Lesley Hill, Carol Maeder, Suzanne Stinson and Dave Lisbon Sorrento manager

The members discussed the grounds maintenance ...starting with the front entrance gardens and the gardens behind the signs. We asked for the hedges to be stair stepped and clean cut edging and weeds to be pulled weekly.

The committee pointed out the Lantana garden on the North side of the Sorrento needs to be cleaned out and new soil added. We asked for a proposal for planting that area with color that would be year round.

The committee asked for proposals for the North and South sides of the curved entrance drive by the front door that would ad year round color.

While we walked the grounds we showed Chandler the Croton garden outside of the west door. The committee is divided about the Crotons because they have been replaced many times. Carol Maeder insisted we just replace them. The cost is \$60.00 .

Suggestions were made for spring and fall flowers for Green Heron to consider..

The meeting was adjourned until January 18th when Chandler will present the proposals...

The committee agreed on Coleus, green and red for the summer flowers, and Geraniums ...red and orange for the fall.

The committee approved Green Herons suggestion Cordylin Toucan for the two North and South gardens at the front entrance.

The committee continued the meeting outside to discuss the Begonias at the front entrance that are not doing well and are not the Begonias that were planted last year. Betty Kraeger and Suzanne Stinson both feel they should be replaced with the Dragon Wings that were suppose to have been planted in those gardens Carole Maeder and Carol Korein said no. The Durantas are dying and Suzanne and Betty feel they should be removed and Carol Maeder insisted they be moved to another area. She insisted they be moved to the Northeast corner of the pool that does not get enough sun and would not make it since they are already dying.

The committee asked for the Ficus Hedge on the East side of the pool to be cut down to just above the fence. Chandler said it would be best to wait until May.

The committee agreed all of the dead Bougainvilleas be removed from the north and south trellises.

Another meeting will be scheduled to discuss Chandlers proposals
