

Social Committee Meeting

February 18, 2011

In attendance: R. Frise, J. Hunt, D. Luttrell, B. McGuire, D. Lisbon (*ex officio*)

A party or two parties need to be rescheduled because all of the Social Committee members either will be up north or entertaining guests when the last party was planned. The committee decided to eliminate the St. Patrick's Potluck and move the Pool Party to Monday, March 21. This will be the "Spring Party" and will feature tenderloin beef sandwiches and everything else potluck. The charge for the beef will be \$10 per person to be collected at the gate by Bob Luttrell.

We estimate that we will probably need 3 whole tenderloins cooked and sliced relatively thin, good rolls (like Publix French hamburger or Chicago rolls), mustard, and horseradish sauce. Donna will pick up rolls and condiments. Joan, Barbara, and Donna volunteered to cook roasts for the party. Donna will make new signs and sign up forms for the party.

Barbara will check on prices for uncooked and cooked tenderloins from Jimmy P's; Donna will get similar prices from Fresh Market.

Price information gathered so far:

- Costco: untrimmed tenderloins are \$9.99 per pound; trimmed tenderloins are \$16.99 per pound. (Trimmed tenderloins were about 4-5 pounds.)
- Jimmy P's: Platters with tenderloin on rolls cost \$10.99 per person. Uncooked tenderloins would be \$13.99 per pound for about a 6 pound roast.
